<p style="text-align: center;">Abstract</p> <p>Objectives/Goals The purpose of my project is to devise a method of solving the Rubiks Cube that is not only simple to learn, but also solves the Rubiks Cube fairly quickly.</p> <p>Methods/Materials Paper, pencil, computer with an Internet connection and a 3x3 Rubiks cube were used. From my research online, I found out that the Fridrich Method was an effective method to solve the Rubiks cube. However, I realized that the second and third steps were way too hard to memorize and use. Hence, I developed new steps to replace them. By stitching all these steps together, I arrived at an optimal algorithmic sequence. This sequence is way easier to learn and memorize.</p> <p>Results The number of moves it takes to solve the Rubiks cube using my method is about 25 percent less compared to the Beginners Method.</p> <p>Conclusions/Discussion I conclude that if the number of operations to solve the Rubiks Cube are reduced, then the Rubiks Cube can be solved quickly and effectively.</p>
